Carl, attached is info on the giant Laser Light Show we're bringing to the American Museum of Natural History's Celebrate 125 festival this weekend (Special Media Preview Friday 6/3). In the past few years, our laser show has been used as the video backdrop for many News 4/Al Roker weather segments. (Enclosed is a B-roll tape of some of those segments.) We would like to do a live remote with News 4 and Al Roker this Friday evening. We are able to projected the News 4 logo, the network logo, "Al's Weather" and just about anything -- 4stories tall -- behind Al, onto the facade of the Museum. This could be combined with a short taped package by Al about lasers. (We can project our multi-colored laser almost anywhere, onto virtually anything, or anyone! We can even miniaturize the beam to project it onto Al's forearm -- with prior notice). Also, the show's creator, Dick Sandhaus, is a great on-camera interview.
